Terms and Conditions for Participation in the *Undergraduate*Excellence Awards 2023

1. Eligibility, Restrictions on Participation

- 1.1 The award is intended for international undergraduate students with exceptional academic records who are interested in research in machine learning, medical imaging and/or augmented reality.
- 1.2 Only individuals may participate in the contest.

2. Organizers

3. Registration, Application

- 3.1 Students must register to participate in the contest.
- 3.2 To apply for the contest, please send an email with a subject **UEAwards2023** to ueawards@mailnavab.informatik.tu-muenchen.de including résumé, academic record, and motivation letter no later than 10 March 2023. Applications will be ranked by academic performance, quality of the motivation letter, and proof of special dedication to medical imaging, computer vision, and/or deep learning.
- 3.3 Applications can only be considered if submitted correctly and within the time limit set out in 3.2.
- 3.4 Application documents will not be returned to the applicant after completion of the contest.

4. Awards, Prizes

4.1 The Chair for Computer Aided Medical Procedures is offering up to 4 awards to the best international undergraduate students who are interested in research in machine learning, medical imaging and augmented reality. The awards amount is up to 4500

Euros. The awarded students will be offered a research project (including scientific supervision and access to the required infrastructure) at the CAMP of the Technical University of Munich for a period of up to three months between June 2023 and October 2023. The awarded students will have the status of visitors and will not receive any salary or other financial support.

- 4.2 The awards will be provided to the selected applicants once they start their research visit at CAMP@TUM in the summer of 2023.
- 4.3 No prize will be awarded if no application is eligible.

5. Confidentiality, Data Protection

- 5.1 The applications submitted will be treated confidential and not be used for purposes other than the conduct of the contest.
- 5.2 The participants agree that their applications and data will be submitted to the jury. The organizer and the jury shall not disclose the applications and data to third parties without the participants' consent, neither during nor after the contest.
- 5.3 After the contest all applications and data submitted will be destroyed by the organizer in compliance with the applicable data protection laws.

6. Liability

- 6.1 The organizer's liability to the participants shall be limited to damage or loss caused by intent or gross negligence. Any liability for loss of profit shall be excluded. The limitation of liability shall not apply to injury to life, body or health.
- 6.2 The participants shall indemnify the organizer from any and all third party claims resulting from copyright infringement, infringement of intellectual property rights or trade secrets or any other rights in connection with the data and/or applications submitted.
- 6.3 The organizer shall assume no liability for the correctness of opinions expressed by members of the jury or other persons participating in the contest.
